

Introduction

The USB Expansion Port lets you use two ports on one bracket, thus minimizing the amount of space used on your workstation. The Port is Windows® 95, Windows NT™, and Windows 98 driven, so additional software is not needed—just plug and play!

Installation

- 1. Unplug your computer.
- 2. Remove your computer's shell or cover.
- 3. Screw the bracket into an open slot on your computer.
- Plug your bracket's 5-pin USB connector onto the USB pins provided on your computer's motherboard (see the top illustration on the next page).
- 5. Place your computer's shell or cover back on to your computer. The 2 exposed jacks are for "A" type USB connectors. (See the bottom illustration on the next page.)
- 6. Plug in your computer.
- 7. Turn on your computer. Installation is complete.
